

## ST. EUSTATIUS

### Visitor Arrival Summary

By the end of 2004, air visitor arrivals, inclusive of residents, to St. Eustatius stood at 21.02 thousand; 4.7 percent more than in 2003. Of this number, tourist arrivals totaled 11.1 thousand which was an increase of 6.0 percent. Antilleans which include residents rose by 3.3 percent.

- ◆ Tourist arrivals out of Holland, the most important market for this destination with a share of 36.2 percent, grew by 2.0 percent. Arrivals from the other main source of tourists also increased in 2004, including the United States (3.6 percent); Other European countries (13.7 percent) and Canada (14.7 percent). Collectively, all other countries accounted for 26.0 percent of total air arrivals and rose by 9.9 percent.
- ◆ Some 6.1 thousand sea arrivals were in St. Eustatius for 2004. This performance meant that for the second consecutive year, this sector expanded. The growth was calculated to be 4.7 percent when compared to the 2003 level.





## ST. LUCIA

### Visitor Arrival Summary

Stay-over arrivals to St. Lucia continued to improve in 2004. This destination welcomed 298.4 thousand tourists, an increase of 7.8 percent when compared to 2003. Each month's performance except for January and May was better than the corresponding month of 2003.


- ◆ Tourist arrivals from the most important market, the United States (accounting for 35.9 percent of all arrivals) increased by 9.2 percent, while those from the second most significant market the United Kingdom increased by 7.9 percent from 75.4 thousand to 81.4 thousand. More tourists also visited from the Caribbean and Other European Countries with the exception of Germany with 8.2 fewer tourists coming to the destination.
- ◆ In 2004, Cruise ship Passenger arrivals grew by 22.4 percent to 481.3 thousand as the destination benefitted from 328 cruise ship calls, 66 calls more calls than in 2003.



## ST VINCENT AND THE GRENADINES

### Visitor Arrival Summary

The number of stop-over tourist arrivals to St. Vincent and the Grenadines increased by 8.2 thousand (10.4 percent) during 2004 to reach 86.7 thousand. The growth of tourist arrivals was steady throughout the year with those coming during the winter season growing by 14.7 while the volume of arrivals in the summer rose by 8.7 percent, moving from 55.9 thousand to 60.8 thousand.


- ◆ The Caribbean provided the largest source of tourists to this destination, with 41.5 percent having originated there in 2004. The 36.0 thousand tourists from this market was an increase of 8.9 percent when compared to 2003. The other markets recovered from last year's weak performance. Arrivals from the United States and the United Kingdom, which are the second and third largest markets for this destination in terms of arrivals, increased by 13.1 percent and 9.2 percent respectively. More tourists also visited from Canada (up 6.1 percent) and Other European countries (up 6.8 percent). Both markets accounted for 6.0 percent to 7.0 percent of total arrivals annually.
- ◆ The largest number of cruise passengers to arrive in St. Vincent and the Grenadines was recorded in 2004. A total of 77.6 thousand in 225 cruise ship calls visited the destinations, 20.1 percent more in 6.3 percent fewer calls. The growth in the sector was recorded in the winter season (up 68.2 percent) which accounted for 72.1 percent of all cruise passengers. In the summer months arrivals dropped by 31.0 percent..



## SURINAME

### Visitor Arrival Summary

During the 2003, the computer software system, Management Information System for Tourism ( MIST) was installed in Suriname. Actual data is available from the second half of the year. A total of 188.6 thousand travelers (including Suriname residents) were recorded at the four ports; Zanferij and Zorg en Hoop Airports and Albina and Nickerie Seaports. Of this total, 137.8 were classified to be tourists.

- ◆ Holland (the Netherlands) constituted Suriname's largest tourist market with 82.2 thousand arrivals, a total share 59.7 percent. The second largest market was the Caribbean with a share of 16.1 percent or 22.2 thousand tourists. Arrivals from South America to this destination in 2004 were 18.1 thousand,3..





## TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO

### Visitor Arrival Summary

The total tourist arrivals to Trinidad and Tobago was 442.6 thousand in 2004. Arrivals therefore continued the upward trend, which was started in 2002, as this performance was an increase of 8.2 percent over that of 2003. Improvements in arrivals levels were recorded in both the winter (12.8 percent) and summer (5.8 percent) seasons.


- ◆ A total of 159.5 thousand tourists originated from the United States in 2004, an increase of 14.8 percent over 2003. This is the major source of tourists (36.0 percent of the total) and its market share increased by 2.0 percentage points. The European countries represented 20.2 percent of the total and arrivals rose by 13.1 percent led by the strong performance in the United Kingdom. Caribbean residents marginally increased their visitation by 0.7 percent, with arrivals from the main Barbados and Guyana decreasing by 5.0 percent and 2.0 percent respectively. The outcomes in the Canadian and South American markets were positive.
  
- ◆ In 2004, the number of cruise passengers declined by 2.3 percent to 54.3 thousand from 55.6 thousand in 2003. This decline in cruise ship arrivals was a result of the reduction of services into the southern Caribbean.



## TURKS AND CAICOS ISLANDS

### Visitor Arrival Summary

Turks and Caicos entertained 150.6 thousand tourists in 2004, 8.2 percent fewer than in 2003, when 164.1 thousand arrivals were recorded.

- ◆ The United States maintained its market share dominance in 2004, accounting for 78.5 percent of all arrivals to this destination. However, fewer tourists originated from this source market, 118.2 thousand tourists compared to 129.0 thousand in 2003. Traffic originating in Canada grew by 9.3 percent, whilst those out of Europe fell by 2.2 after last year's robust growth of 23.1 percent.





## US VIRGIN ISLANDS

### Visitor Arrival Summary

The United States Virgin Islands hosted some 655.0 thousand tourists and same-day visitors in 2004, an increase of 5.5 percent when compared to 2003. Tourist arrivals, which accounted for 83.0 percent or 543.6 thousands arrivals, increased by 1.1. While the number of same-day visitors grew by 34.4 percent from 82.9 thousand in 2003 to 111.4 thousand in 2004.

- ◆ Non-resident hotel registration is used as a proxy to study the trends in the main tourism markets in this destination. In 2004, some 86.6 percent of the registrations were from the United States. These registrations was an increase of 6.1 percent when compared to the performance of 2003. Reported hotel registrations of Europeans rose by 104.1 percent but accounted for only 2.6 percent of the total. The second largest market for this destination is the Caribbean with a market share of 5.2 percent. From this market, 9.1 percent more person were entertained than in the previous year. Canada and Latin America also did much better in 2004 than in 2003.
- ◆ The US Virgin Islands registered an increase in cruise passenger arrivals of 10.8 percent to reach 1,964.7 thousand. There was an associated 4.2 percent rise in cruise ship calls with 925 calls being made in 2004.








